







PROCEDURES



Wear protective equipment.



Place wet floor signs.



Remove excess solids.



Either blot with a clean white towel or extract.





IF: You don't rinse...

THEN: The spot will come back.









PROCEDURES FOR HAND SPOTTING:



Apply chemical.



Gently agitate toward the center. Allow dwell time.



Blot up spot. Don't rub. For best results, use a tamping brush.




Rinse with clean water. Blot. For best results, use a tamping brush.




PROCEDURES FOR EXTRACTION SPOTTING:



Apply chemical.




Gently agitate toward the center. Allow dwell time.



Rinse extract with clean water.












Vacuum entry mats.



For best results, use a carpet groomer to provide agitation.



Vacuum hallways, traffic lanes and visible soil.



Vacuum under trash cans and furniture.




Spot vacuum furniture and upholstery.



Vacuum edges and corners.





Empty vacuum bag and clean filter.




Vacuum thoroughly and remove spots.



Mix cleaning solution.




Place wet floor signs.



Spray carpet with bonnet cleaning solution in a pressure sprayer.




Spray bonnet with solution or soak bonnet in cleaner.



Overlap your passes.



Flip, change or rinse bonnet as needed.



Allow appropriate dry time before traffic.













Vacuum area thoroughly and remove spots.



Mix prespray in pressure sprayer.




Place wet floor signs.



Spray carpet with a prespray solution in a pressure sprayer.



For best results, use a carpet groomer to provide agitation.



Allow 5 minutes dwell time before proceeding with cleaning.

GOOFS and CONSEQUENCES





IF: You prespray too large an area...

THEN: The prespray will



IF: You don't prespray the carpet...

THEN: Your carpet may not get clean.



IF: You over mix the chemical...

THEN: The carpet will attract soil.
